

# Deeside Gliding Club Trial Flight Notes – Summer 2021

## 1. Wellness and Fitness to Fly

To protect your pilot and others on the airfield, if you have a flight booked and you or any of your party feel unwell (especially if you have a temperature, cough, loss of taste or smell, cold symptoms etc) please let us know and do not come out to the airfield.

## 2. Miscellaneous

We understand that people taking trial flights want to share the experience with friends and family, but we ask you to keep the number in your party to a reasonable number and respect the current government rules on mixing households when visiting the airfield.

On arrival there is paperwork to complete prior to flying. Please arrive no more than 30 minutes before your flight time and expect to be on site about 1 hour. All times are approximate due to weather. Wear normal outdoor clothes, not too bulky as the cockpit is a snug fit with 5 x point harness and parachute. In order to comply with Civil Aviation Authority regulations, you will be weighed before your flight. Remember to bring your voucher as payment for the flight.

## 3. Hygiene

You and your pilot will be required to wear a face covering during your flight. Please bring your own face covering if possible although the club also has a limited supply.

Washing hands regularly is the best way of killing the virus therefore hand washing for 20 seconds should be carried out when you arrive at the club prior to flying.

Hand sanitizer is provided at various locations in the airfield.

## 4. Clubhouse

Unfortunately the clubhouse is not in use other than for toilets.

## 5. Refreshments

The club can usually provide a number of different refreshments however due to the restrictions no food or drink is available at this time so please bring your own.

## 6. Launch point cabin

We have a shelter at the east end of the airfield but unfortunately this is not in use. If we are launching from this end and you have any mobility issues you may take your car to the launch point. Please be aware your insurance company may not cover your vehicle on the airfield.

## 7. Flying

To ensure your safety, the aircraft is sanitised after every flight to ensure there is no virus transmission from the aircraft surfaces.

**Please, when at the club, protect yourself and other members by observing the social distancing 2 meters at all times.**
